*A Law to amend the Institute of Management and Technology Law,
Cap. 97 Revised Laws of Enugu State, 2004.*

Title.

Be it enacted by the Enugu State House of Assembly as follows -

Enactment.

1. This Law may be cited as the Institute of Management and Technology (Amendment) Law, 2016 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on **15th day of November, 2016.**

Citation and date of commencement.

2. In this Law -

Interpretation.

“Principal Law” means the Institute of Management and Technology Law, Cap. 97 Revised Laws of Enugu State, 2004.

3. (a) by substituting Section 3(1) with the following new Section as follows -

Amendment of the Principal Law

3(1) “There is established in the State an institute to be known as Institute of Management and Technology Enugu which shall be an institution for teaching, training and research in management and applied technology of a standard above that obtainable in a post-primary school with its registered office and main campus at Enugu and other campuses located at other parts of the State to be determined by the council with the approval of the Governor”.

(b) by inserting a new subsection (2) to Section 3 as follows -

3(2) The Campuses of the institute as stipulated in sub-section (1) of this Section shall house the schools of the institute to be determined by the Council.

(c) by re-numbering sub-section (2) of Section 3 to sub-section (3) and inserting the phrase “for the purpose of its functionaries under this Law immediately after the word “property”


(d) by inserting the following new Section 4 and re-numbering other sections accordingly.

4. The objects of the institute shall be to -

Section.

(a) Provide facilities for learning and to give instruction and training in such branches of knowledge as the institute may

desire to foster and in doing so, to enable students to obtain the advantages of liberal education;

- (b) Promote by research and other means the advancement of knowledge and its practical application to social, political, cultural, economic, scientific and technological problems;
 - (c) Stimulate particularly through teaching and research interest in scientific growth and advancement;
 - (d) Stimulate, sustain and advance interest in entrepreneurship and agriculture;
 - (e) Serve as a major instrument for the implementation of the policy of the State on higher education; and
 - (f) Undertake any other activities appropriate to an institute and such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the institute.
- (e) Amendment rejected. The phrase remains as in section 5(1)(b) of the original law.
- (f) By inserting a new sub-section (3) to section 6 as follows –
“The Registrar shall hold office for a period of 3 years and may be re-appointed for further period of 3 years and no more”.
- (g) By deleting the word “three” in Section 7 and replacing it with the word “four”.
- (h) By inserting the word “degrees” immediately after the word “award” in Section 9(1).
- (i) By replacing the provisions of Section 10 with the following new provision –
“Service under the institute shall be same as obtainable in equivalent sectors in the State Public Service and shall be approved service for pension-purpose”.
- (j) By deleting the phrase “in Enugu” in Section 12(1) and replacing it with the phrase “within the State”.
- (k) By replacing paragraphs (d) and (e) of Section 23(2) with the following new provisions: “(d) the institute librarian; and (e) Chief Lecturers”.
- (l) By adding the word “degrees” immediately after the word “certificates” in Section 24(1)(a).
- (m) By adding the word “degree” immediately after the word “final” in Section 25.
- (n) By adding the word “degrees” immediately after the word “awarding” in Section 27(1).
