ENUGU STATE OF NIGERIA 2017, No. 3

A Law to amend the Schools Transfer Law, Cap. 141 Revised Laws of Title. Enugu State 2004.

Be it enacted by the House of Assembly of Enugu State of Nigeria as follows-

Enactment.

1. This Law may be cited as the Schools Transfer (Amendment) Law, 2017 and shall be deemed to come into effect on 2nd day of March, 2017.

Citation and date of commencement.

2. In this Law-

Interpretation.

"Principal Law" means the Schools Transfer Law, Cap. 141 Revised Laws of Enugu State 2004.

3. The Principal Law is amended as follows -

Amendment of the Principal Law

- (a) In subsection 3(4), in line six by deleting the words "two hundred naira" after the word "of" and insert the words "two hundred thousand naira".
- (b) In subsection 5(2)(b), in lines two and three, by deleting the words "six hundred naira" after the word "of" and insert the words "five hundred thousand naira".
- (c) In section 6, by inserting (1) immediately after the number 6 and inserting the following new subsections (2) and (3).
 - (2) The Voluntary Agency shall recommend to the Enugu State Universal Basic Education Board (ENSUBEB) who shall be appointed a Head Teacher in the Primary School based on competence.
 - (3) The Voluntary Agency shall make recommendation to the Enugu State Universal Basic Education Board (ENSUBEB) during recruitment exercise.
- (d) In section 13, by inserting (1) immediately after the number 13 and inserting the following new subsections (2), (3) and (4)-

Section.



- (2) The Government may at her discretion give subvention and grant-in-aids to the Voluntary Agency for running of their post primary schools.
- (3) The Government shall continue to fund the primary schools handed over to the Voluntary Agencies.
- (4) The Government shall liaise with the Voluntary Agency to determine the fees charged in Voluntary Agency Schools.
- (e) By deleting the marginal note in Section 13 and inserting the following new marginal note "Finance and funding"
- (f) In section 15, by inserting (1) immediately after the number 15 and inserting the following new subsections (2), and (3)
 - (2) The general supervision in post primary schools shall be carried out jointly by the Voluntary Agency, Ministry of Education, Post Primary Schools Management Board (PPSMB), and State Technical and Vocational Schools Management Board (STVSMB).
 - (3) The general supervision in primary schools shall be carried out jointly by the Voluntary Agency, Ministry of Education and Enugu State Universal Basic Education Board (ENSUBEB).
- (g) By inserting immediately after section 17 the following new sections 18
 - 18(1) Subject to section 6 of this Law, the teaching and non teaching staff appointed by the Commission shall in respect of their service be entitled to pensions, gratuities and other retirement benefits.
 - (2) Nothing in this section shall prevent the appointment by the Voluntary Agency of a teaching or non teaching staff to work in the Voluntary Agency School or Institution on terms and conditions which preclude the grant of pension or gratuity.

EXPLANATORY NOTES


This Law seeks to amend the Principal Law and make the guidelines purportedly made in the Transfer of Schools to Voluntary Agencies Order, 2009 un-operational, as the Governor exceeded his powers in making such guidelines.
