A law to Amend the Local Government Law (Cap. 109) Laws of Enugu Title. State 2004, and to Provide for Matters Connected Therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Enugu State House of Assembly as follows -

Enactment.

This Law may be cited as the Local Government (Amendment)
 Law 2015 and shall be deemed to come into force on 29th day of
 December, 2015.

Citation and date of commencement.

In this Law –
 "Principal Law" means the Local Government Law (Cap. 109),
 Laws of Enugu State, 2004.

Interpretation.

3. The Principal Law is amended as follows -

Amendment of the Principal Law.


- (a) by deleting the phrase "of three months" in section 12(2) thereof and replacing it with the phrase "not exceeding two years";
- (b) by adding a new paragraph 12(2) (a) to read as follows -(12(2)(a)) "The Transitional Committee appointed under section 12 of this Law may be dissolved or member(s) removed by the Governor."
