A Law to Amend the Enugu State Christian Pilgrims Welfare Board Law, Cap. 43 Revised Laws of Enugu State 2004. Title.

Be it enacted by the Enugu State House of Assembly as follows -

Enactment.

1. This Law may be cited as Enugu State Christian Pilgrims Welfare Board (Amendment) Law2016, and shall be deemed to come into force on 20th day of September, 2016.

Citation and date of commencement.

2. In this Law –

Interpretation.

"Principal Law" means Enugu State Christian Pilgrims Welfare Board Law, Cap. 43 Revised Laws of Enugu State 2004.

- 3, The Principal Law is amended as follows -
 - (a) By substituting section 7 with the following new section 7 –

Amendment of the Principal Law

Secretary to the

Board


7(1) The Governor shall appoint any person with cognate knowledge and experience in the practice of Christian Religion to be Executive Secretary to the Board.

(2) Subject to the general supervision and oversight of the Board, the Executive Secretary shall—

(a) be the accounting officer of the Board;

- (b)be responsible for the day to day administration of the Board;
- (c) upon the directive of the Board, summon all meetings of the Board;
- (d) keep records of the proceedings of the Board;
- (e) keep custody of the seal of the Board; and
- (f) perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to him by the Board.
- (3) The Executive Secretary shall be an officer, but not a member of the Board.
- (4) The Executive Secretary shall hold office for a period of four years and may be re-appointed for another term and no more.
- (b) by deleting the marginal notes in Sections 10,14,15,16,18

and 20 and inserting new marginal notes as follows-



- "Board to comply with directives of Governor" for section 10:
- "Accounts" for section 14;
- "Audit" for section 15;
- "Annual report and estimates" for section 16;
- "Regulation of proceedings" for section 18; and
- "Regulations" for section 20.
- by deleting Part VIII Miscellaneous(sections 34, 35, 36. 37 and 38 as they are not part of the Principal Law).

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
